

ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 73 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO ONE-WAY STREETS

WHEREAS, Chapter 73, Schedule I, of the Municipal Code of the City of Mineral Point, Iowa County, Wisconsin, restricts vehicle travel on certain City streets to one direction only; and

WHEREAS, Schedule I of Chapter 73 of the Municipal Code was amended on April 13, 2011, by Ordinance # 747, restricting vehicle traffic on Jail Alley to west-bound only, commencing ninety (90) feet west of the intersection of Jail Alley and Vine Street and ending one hundred and seventy (170) feet east of the intersection of Jail Alley and North Chestnut Street; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance and Claims Committee of the Common Council of the City of Mineral Point, at a meeting held on January 31, 2013, recommended that the above referenced one-way restriction to a part of Jail Alley be rescinded due to the completion of construction in the area; and


WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Mineral Point has determined that such rescission is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Mineral Point;

NOW THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Mineral Point does ordain that Ordinance #747 of the Municipal Code be rescinded, that Schedule I of Chapter 73 of the Municipal Code be amended to delete the reference to Jail Alley as a one way street, and that two way traffic is hereby allowed on all parts of Jail Alley.

Adopted at a meeting of the Common Council of the City of Mineral Point, held on February 5, 2013, at the City Council Chambers, in the City of Mineral Point, Iowa County, Wisconsin.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
